

plan. Upon Commission approval, the Licensee shall implement the plan, including any changes required by the Commission.

Article 406. The Licensee shall, within 180 days of the issuance of this license, file for Commission approval a plan and schedule for providing in the immediate vicinity of the existing Brown's Bridge, located one mile below the Project powerhouse, an instantaneous minimum flow of not less than 100 cfs. At the same time that it makes its filing with the Commission, the Licensee shall provide the North Carolina Department of Environment, Health and Natural Resources and the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency with a copy of its plan and schedule. The Commission reserves the right to require changes to the plan. Upon Commission approval, the Licensee shall implement the plan, including any changes required by the Commission.

Article 407. (a) For the purpose of providing flows for recreational rafting and boating on the Pigeon River downstream of the Project, the Licensee, beginning in May of 1995, or earlier if requested in writing by the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency (TWRA), shall commence releasing from the Project powerhouse water sufficient to ensure that flows in the Pigeon River in the immediate vicinity of the existing Brown's Bridge located one mile downstream of the Project powerhouse meet or exceed 1,200 cfs from (Schedule [1]) 1:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. on two weekdays during each week as well as 12:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Saturdays, as measured at
