

Article 408. The Licensee shall, within 180 days of the date of issuance of this license, after consultation with the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency (TWRA), file for Commission approval a plan for the Licensee to ensure the installation, operation, and maintenance of a streamflow gage in the Pigeon River in the immediate vicinity of the existing Brown's Bridge located one mile downstream of the Project powerhouse to monitor the flows required by Article 406 and Article 407.

The plan shall include a schedule for installing the gage, determination of the location and general design features of the gage, the method of flow data collection, and a provision for providing the flow data to TWRA and the Commission within 30 days after the date a request for the data is made. The Licensee shall include with the plan documentation of consultation and copies of comments and recommendations on the completed plan after it has been prepared and provided to TWRA and specific descriptions of how TWRA's comments are addressed by the plan. The Licensee shall allow a minimum of 30 days for TWRA to comment and to make recommendations prior to filing the plan with the Commission. If the Licensee does not adopt a recommendation, the filing shall include the Licensee's reasons for not doing so.

The Commission reserves the right to require changes to the plan. Upon Commission approval, the Licensee shall implement the plan, including any changes required by the Commission.
