

after notice and opportunity for hearing and after consultation with appropriate state and federal agencies, may require the Licensee to take appropriate action to address dioxin contamination of the sediments in the Project reservoir upon a finding that such action is necessary and in the public interest.

Article 410. The Licensee shall implement the provisions of the Programmatic Agreement Among The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, The Advisory Council On Historic Preservation, And The North Carolina State Historic Preservation Officer, For Managing Historic Properties That May Be Affected By A New License Issuing To Carolina Power & Light Company For The Continued Operation Of The Walters Hydroelectric Project In North Carolina that was first executed on _____. The Commission reserves the right to include such additional requirements in this license as may be necessary to ensure the Commission's compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act and implementing regulations, particularly those at 36 CFR Part 800, at any time during the term of this license, in the event the Programmatic Agreement is terminated.

Article 411. (a) The following proposals included in the Licensee's Recreation Report, filed October 1, 1990, and revised April 15, 1991, are hereby approved and shall be implemented by the Licensee as specified herein: (1) enhance the canoe launch area below the Project powerhouse (p. V-15, Figure V.
