

Environment, Health and Natural Resources Division of Parks and Recreation, and the United States Forest Service, as appropriate, in developing the maps, drawings, and schedule required by paragraph (c)(1) hereof. The Licensee shall provide these agencies with a copy of the maps, drawings and schedule at least 30 days prior to submitting them to the Commission for approval, and shall file with the Commission at the time it submits the maps, drawings, and schedule for approval any written comments it receives from these agencies on them.

Article 412. The Commission reserves the right, after notice and opportunity for hearing, to require the Licensee to construct, and operate and maintain during the term of this license, canoe/boat portage facilities in the White Oak Township adjacent to the Project reservoir; provided, however, that the Commission cannot require the Licensee to construct, operate, or maintain portage facilities unless and until the State of North Carolina has rescinded in total its 1988 fish consumption advisory for the Project reservoir. Such portage facilities shall consist of an unpaved access road from White Oak Road (Haywood County Road SR 1346) to an area near the confluence of Stevens Creek and the Project reservoir, a parking area for 6-10 vehicles, a vehicle turn-around area, and a trail to the inlet area of Stevens Creek.

Article 413. The Licensee shall, within 150 days of the date of issuance of this license, either modify its April 25, 1991
